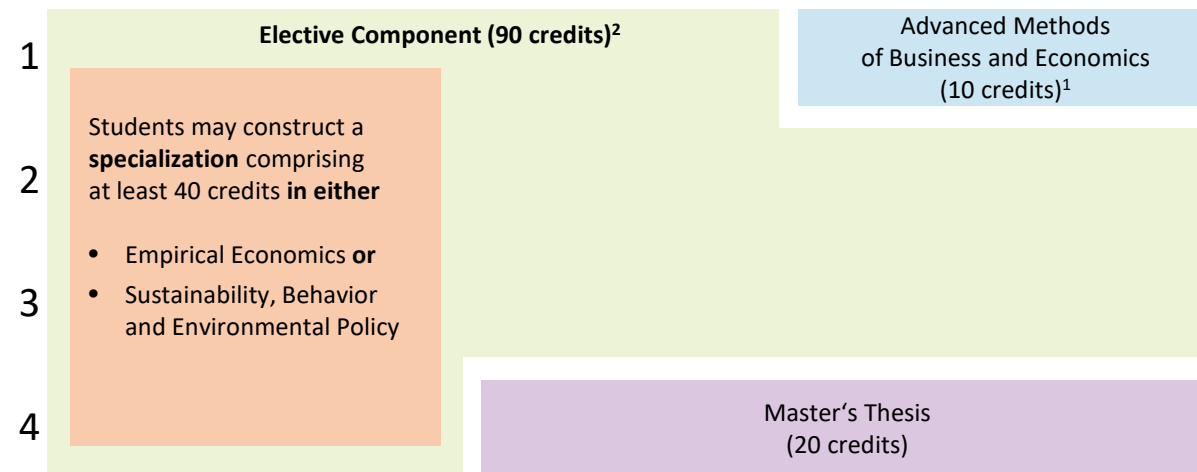


Master of Science in Economics (120 credits in four semesters)

¹Students may complete the compulsory module Advanced Methods of Business and Economics in either their first or in their second semester, depending on the time of their admission to the program. The above figure depicts the course of study for admission in the winter semester. This module provides students with advanced knowledge in microeconomic methods for business and economics and in econometric analysis. It takes an applied approach using concrete examples.

²The elective component comprises a total of 90 credits. Students must complete at least 60 credits in this component in courses in economics and quantitative methods and at least 10 credits in business administration. Courses in the elective component may be combined to form one of the two specializations.
