

One Study Programme

– two Universities

The program is jointly offered by the Universities of Bamberg and Erlangen-Nuremberg in Bayaria/Germany. Together, the two institutes offer an internationally cutting-edge range of expertise, with leading specialists in Islamic Studies, Arab, Iranian, Jewish and Turkish Studies, Islamic Art and Archaeology, Linguistics, and History.



Master • 4 Semester • 120 ECTS-Points

The duration of study of this modularized program is four semesters in full-time (8 semesters in part-time). Students participate in the shared foundational modules, then they select one of five areas of specialization: History, Art and Archaeology, Religious Studies, Language and Literature, Linguistics. The core component of the programme is the module "Theories and Methods", in which students organize and conduct their own workshop.

Course content is offered in both English and German, and for the specialization areas Islamic Art and Archaeology and Linguistics entirely in English.

Students are encouraged to learn German.

The Complementary Area is used to strengthen and supplement the individual study profile and offers a great scope: Courses from the participating disciplines e.g. language courses or courses from the political sciences at the University of Erlangen-Nuremberg, or „Internet Computing for the humanities“ could be successfully completed in the subsidiary area. Two internships of at least three weeks each are also part of this module area.
