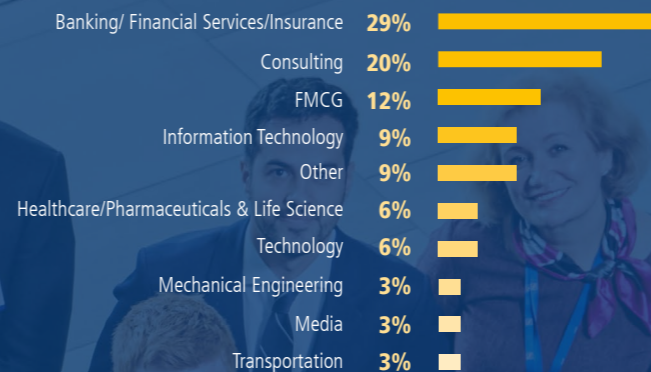
Corporate connections

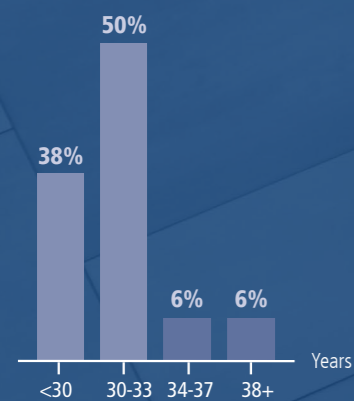

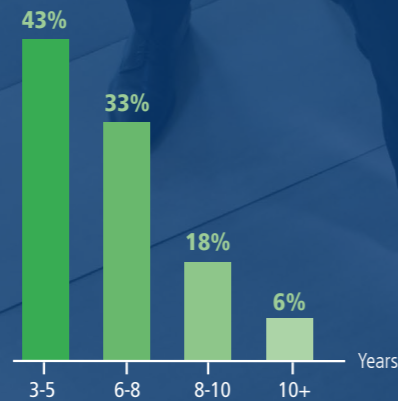

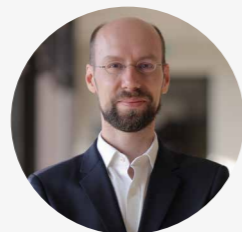

Leadership Camp

The programme starts with a team-building weekend. During these activity-packed two days, our new MBA candidates start developing many of the key skills they will employ throughout the programme, including teamwork, communication and time management.



Pre-Courses (optional)

One month before the official programme starts, you will get access to free online courses to prepare ahead of the first module. These courses are held online with the Part-Time students.



Skill Courses (optional)

The programme offers a combination of complementary approaches to develop transferable management skills (e.g. leadership in crisis situations and design thinking) and enhance the personal development of students. The interactive teaching and learning methodology employed in these modules has proven particularly beneficial for candidates. Participation is optional but strongly recommended.



Core Modules, Specialisations/Electives

The core modules focus on three key areas and are composed of a broad scope of courses providing you with a solid business management foundation. For your Specialisation, you choose electives from "Advanced Development" and/or "Finance & Technology". You either select six electives from one category or three electives from each category, enabling you to customise your learning experience.



Module Abroad

Grow your international network while completing your one-week module abroad, Innovation, at SDA Bocconi School of Management in Milan, Italy. The engaging learning environment at one of Europe's top leading business schools make the experience particularly interesting and rewarding on many different levels.

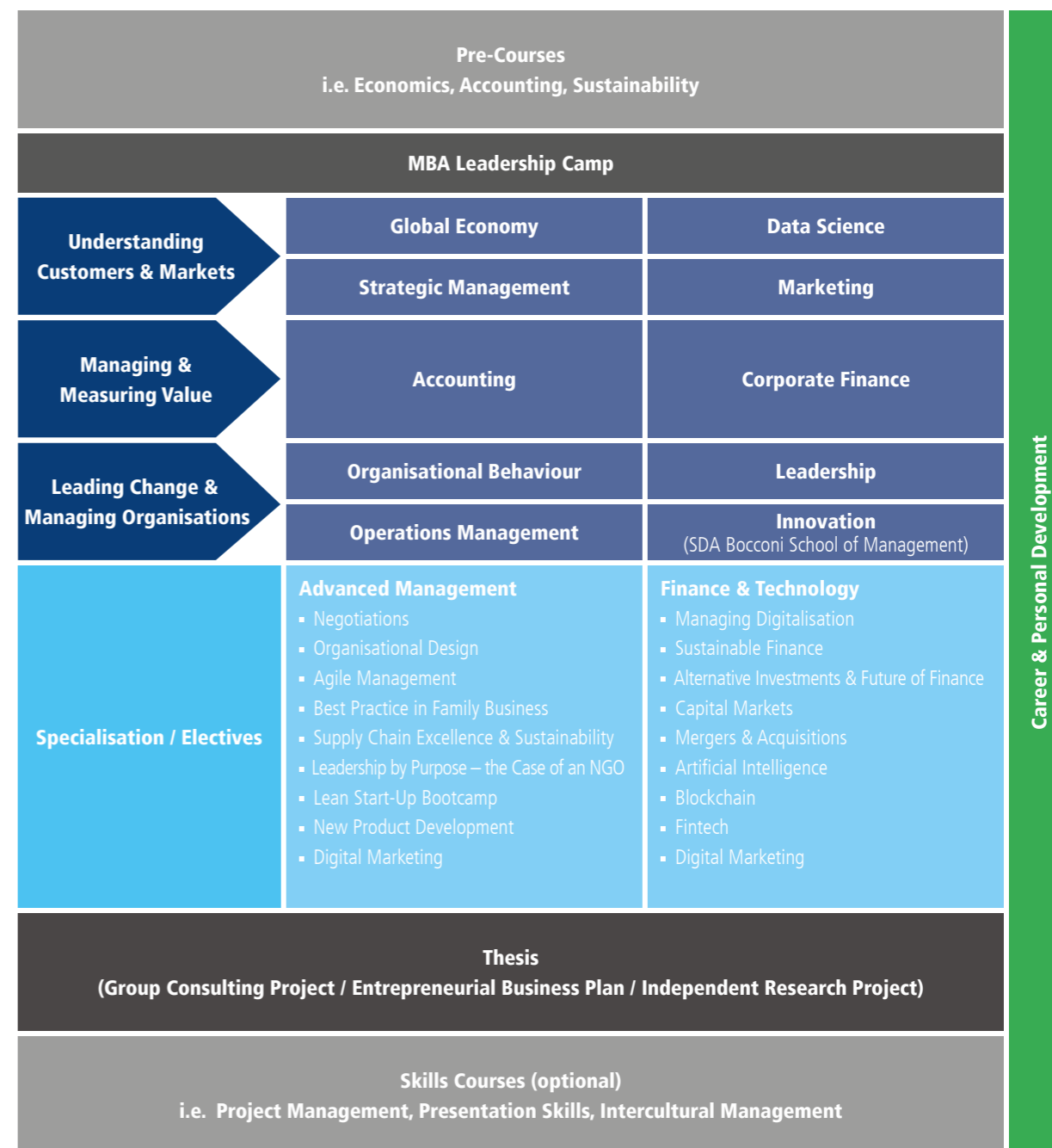
