#### Admission requirements

- Completed, first university degree of min. 240 ECTS credit points in a healthrelated science
- At least two years of work experience in the health-sector proven by references from (former) employers covering the candidate's work experience of at least two years
- English Language Proficiency: Level C1 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) evidenced by TOEFL 95-120; IELTS 6.5-7.5; native speaker or entire academic education in English


