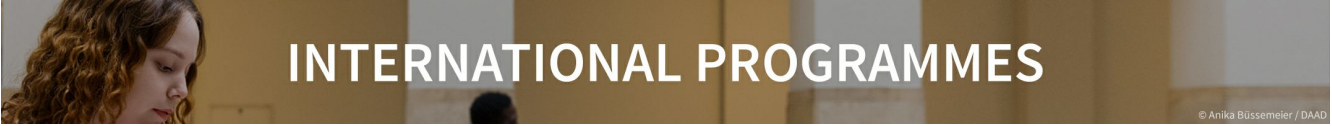

Languages	The doctoral thesis may be written in German or English. In the case of an international dissertation agreement, the students have the opportunity to write in their official language. The oral examination will be in German or English.

Description/content	<p>A one- to two-year postgraduate course of study at the Faculty of Law of the University of Münster</p> <p>A particular requirement of the doctoral programme is that each candidate must submit a doctoral thesis showing his or her ability to carry out independent research and constituting a substantial contribution to the legal field.</p> <p>The doctoral examination consists of the doctoral thesis and an oral examination.</p>

<b>Tuition fees per semester in EUR</b>	None
<b>Semester contribution</b>	<p>Students must pay a semester contribution fee of 317.48 EUR per semester. <b>Academic admission requirements</b>	In order to be admitted to the Doctor Juris programme, the applicant is required to have completed a "Magister Legum" or a Master's programme in "German Law" at any law faculty in Germany ("magna cum laude").
