#### Description/content

The interdisciplinary MA InterAmerican Studies / Estudios InterAmericanos focuses on social, cultural, historical, and political developments in the Americas both in their specifically national characteristics and in regard to processes of transnational integration. The programme is characterised by a broad interdisciplinary approach to Hemispheric area studies and includes the disciplines of literary, cultural, and media studies, linguistics, sociology, political science, and transnational history. The larger context of current research questions of transnationality, of interculturality, of globalisation, and of the world society is of central interest.

#### **Course Details**

#### Course organisation

The InterAmerican Studies / Estudios InterAmericanos Master's programme is structured according to basic and optional complementary modules. There are four basic modules which should be completed during the first two semesters, together with the individual electives module. The basic modules cover seminars on North and South American culture, literature, history and language. During the second year of the programme, students are to complete two optional complementary modules, choosing their major and specialising in literature and culture and/or linguistic and/or history and politics and/or social studies of the American continent. An additional graduation module consisting of the Master's thesis and a research colloquium is to be completed during the last semester of the programme.

### Integrated/optional study abroad unit(s)

The InterAmerican Studies / Estudios InterAmericanos MA programme aims at educating experts in the fields of international, cultural, social and communication processes. Students have the opportunity to choose between the double degree option or going abroad for a semester on a

student exchange to Latin America or the United States.

The structure of the double degree option is designed so that each generation of students will study the first two semesters at Bielefeld University, where they will acquire the basis of interdisciplinary studies. The remaining two semesters will be spent at Universidad de Guadalajara in Maestría de Literaturas Interamericanas, where they must write their thesis, which will be supervised by professors from both institutions.

This way, students are given the opportunity to apply the theoretical knowledge acquired during their studies in a concrete, cultural, social and political environment of the Americas, at the same time conducting the necessary field research.

The programme offers the possibility to choose specific complementary modules from the special research and educational offers of our partner universities. Most importantly, the exchange programmes offer students the possibility of a double supervision ("co-tutelle") for their Master's theses. Agreements have been established with the following universities:

### Requirements / Registration

#### Academic admission requirements

The following documents are needed in order to apply:

- Certificate of undergraduate studies or equivalent degree in disciplines related to InterAmerican Studies\*
- Transcript of records\*
- Language certificates for English (B2) and Spanish (B2)
- Short text samples proving your intercultural skills (300 to 400 words), interdisciplinary skills (300 to 400 words), and InterAmerican research skills (300 to 400 words) in English or Spanish
- Applicants to the MA InterAmerican Studies programme who wish to pursue the double degree in Literaturas Interamericanas must mention that in their application.

\*Certificates that are not issued in English or German must be officially translated to one of these languages.

#### Language requirements

Applicants must provide proof of their advanced Spanish and English skills (B2 level in both languages).

#### Possibility of finding parttime employment

Basically, with your residence permit (stamp in your passport), you will receive a work permit for 120 work days per year. This allows you to work 120 full days (eight hours per day) or 240 half days (up to four hours per day). This condition must be noted expressly in the passport by the authorities.

Please try to secure accommodation in Bielefeld as early as possible. In Bielefeld, a broad range of accommodation options can be found at affordable prices. Students residences are run by the public "Studierendenwerk" or private organisations, and shared flats are very common.
