Description/content	ESMT Berlin's Master's in Global Management (MGM) is an innovative programme that prepares you to lead in the world of tomorrow. This century presents unprecedented challenges, and the MGM			

will equip you to live up to these situations. You will gain an understanding of how businesses shape the global economy and how managers and strategy consultants can contribute to making a positive impact.

Students will complete **multiple projects and internships** with global companies before graduation, and some of this work should be done abroad. Balanced with soft skills and career reflection in the classroom, the programme will help students become individuals who are more aware and who can make a difference in their organisations. Examples of corporations who provided internships to our students include Allianz, Amazon, Audi, Bosch, Deutsche Bank, DHL, E.ON, McKinsey, Porsche, and Siemens.

The programme has the following key focus areas:

- Global Immersion: Become a truly global business leader through options like internships, an academic term abroad, and take advantage of language training as integral part of the curriculum.
- Finance Certificate: As part of your elective course choice, you can opt to complete five advanced courses in Finance subjects with a focus on global investment strategies.
- Portfolio Management Programme: The Portfolio Management Programme (PMP) is an
 optional two-year elective in which selected students actively manage a real-money
 portfolio of one million EUR per group with a total portfolio value of three million EUR. The
 concept of the PMP enables participants to combine theory and practice to develop real
 trading strategies on the open market.
- Social Impact Project: A five-week project during the second year of your studies, it offers
 students the opportunity to serve as an economic or management consultant for an
 organisation with specific social impact objectives, such as a non-profit organisation, a CSR
 department, a social entrepreneurship venture, or a social impact project of a for-profit
 organisation.

The ESMT MGM programme uses an interdisciplinary approach. Students apply analytical models to understand the global economy, product development, and new techniques in technology management within global companies. Students planning to pursue a further academic career also have unique access to research practices and projects with ESMT's faculty.

Course Details

Course organisation

The Master's in Global Management programme lasts for 24 months.

The structure in two parts includes:

- Foundation courses covering the most important areas of management theory and practice, with a focus on their importance for the globalised world of the 21st century, e.g. strategy, economics, finance, operations, organisational behaviour, leadership and sustainability, politics
- Advanced electives delving deeper into industries and applications, e.g. digital business transformation, negotiation, data analytics, innovation

The Master's programme is divided up into the following terms:

- Term 1: From September to December, you will study core courses, such as "The State of the World", "Financial Management and Corporate Finance", and "Competitive Strategy", as well as skills seminars and a language choice.
- Term 2: From January to April, core courses include "The Global Economy", "Business
 Leadership in Society", and others. You will also cover skills seminars such as "Cross
 Cultural Management" and "Building Professional Networks", and study a language of your
 choice.
- Summer break: From April to September, students complete a mandatory internship of up
 to six months with a company and industry that meet their career goals. In previous years,
 ESMT students did internships with companies such as Accenture, BMW, United Nations,
 Google, Bayer Healthcare, and many more.
- **Term 3**: From October to December, students attend electives and skill seminars as well as a course in their language of choice.

- **Term 4**: From January to September, students go on their Social Impact Project, attend more electives, skills seminars and their language choice.
- Master's Thesis: While working on their theses from June to August (three months), students may seek the opportunity of a second internship and carry out their research with support from practitioners. Alternatively, particularly those who intend to pursue an academic career may opt for working on a thesis topic in close coordination with a professor's own research agenda.

International elements

Integrated internships

ESMT MGM students have the opportunity to complete at least one internship during the programme:

- 1. First-year internship: students begin this mandatory internship after they have completed the first two terms in the MGM programme. They have been trained in foreign languages, project management, and soft skills before beginning the internship.
- 2. Optional Master's thesis internship: students have completed their first internship, completed the Social Impact Project and received further project management and soft skills training. For this last part of the programme, MGM candidates have the choice to undertake an optional second internship while writing their theses. Students may also choose to forego the second internship and follow a more academic approach to their theses.

Scholarships are awarded based on merit. In addition, ESMT collaborates with the international loan provider Prodigy Finance as well as the Brain Capital funding scheme.

Requirements / Registration

Academic admission requirements

- A previous degree (at least Bachelor's equivalent) is required. See details below.
- Ideally, applicants should have no more than 24 months of postgraduate work experience.
- Completed application, including essays and one reference
- Individual interview online

As a **previous degree**, at least a Bachelor's degree is required. Applications will also be accepted from final-year undergraduate students awaiting completion of their degree programmes.

Language requirements

ESMT expects a score of 100 points in the TOEFL or 7.0 in the IELTS or 850 in the TOEIC.

You will receive a waiver for the English proficiency test if English is your native language or if you have completed a university degree completely taught in English.

Application deadline

Applications are reviewed on arolling, first-come basis. The Admissions Committee meets and publishes admissions decisions every two weeks.

Possibility of finding parttime employment

ESMT expects the companies participating in the ESMT's internship programme to pay students between 700 EUR and 2,000 EUR per month during their internships.

Accommodation

On-campus accommodation is not available. Students are responsible for finding an apartment and signing a personal lease, but they will be supported by ESMT Student Services.

Career advisory service

Career management is an integral part of the MGM programme with regular seminars built into the programme schedule. From day one, students start working on their CV and on their interview skills. They take part in company presentations on the ESMT campus, attend company visits around Germany, and attend the on-campus ESMT Career Fair. By the end of the MGM programme, they will better understand how to strategically plan their job searches, navigate their own career paths, build and activate their own networks, and negotiate their desired salaries.
