Course organisation	<p>STUDYING DIGITAL MEDIA</p> <p>The Bachelor's degree programme at Leuphana University in Lüneburg consists of four basic elements: the Digital Media major (90 ECTS credits), the minor (30 ECTS credits), the Leuphana Semester (30 ECTS credits), and the Complementary Studies (30 ECTS credits).</p> <p>The Bachelor's degree programme in Digital Media begins with the Leuphana Semester, during which you will learn the methodological and disciplinary foundations of your academic specialisation in digital media. From the second semester, your Bachelor's programme will be divided into the Digital Media major, a minor of your choice (e.g. Popular Music Studies, Philosophy, Psychology and Society or Sustainability Science), and Complementary Studies. In the Complementary Studies, you can try out new ways of working and thinking from other disciplines, allowing you to expand your interdisciplinary skills.</p> <p>Half of the courses will take place at Hamburg Media School. The other half will be taught at Leuphana University Lüneburg.</p> <p>» PDF Download</p>
