Description/content	<p>Intensive course for all levels of German: from beginner to advanced (i.e. for students of German studies)</p> <p>A general knowledge of the language can be acquired or broadened. Students will be taught listening and reading comprehension through guided exercises. They will participate in oral exercises and expand their vocabulary as well as receive instruction in grammar and phonetics. Methods and materials are up to date and lessons follow a communicative approach.</p> <p>In the afternoons, participants can join optional tutorials to further practise their speaking, writing, and pronunciation skills and to get to know cultural and regional aspects of Germany.</p>

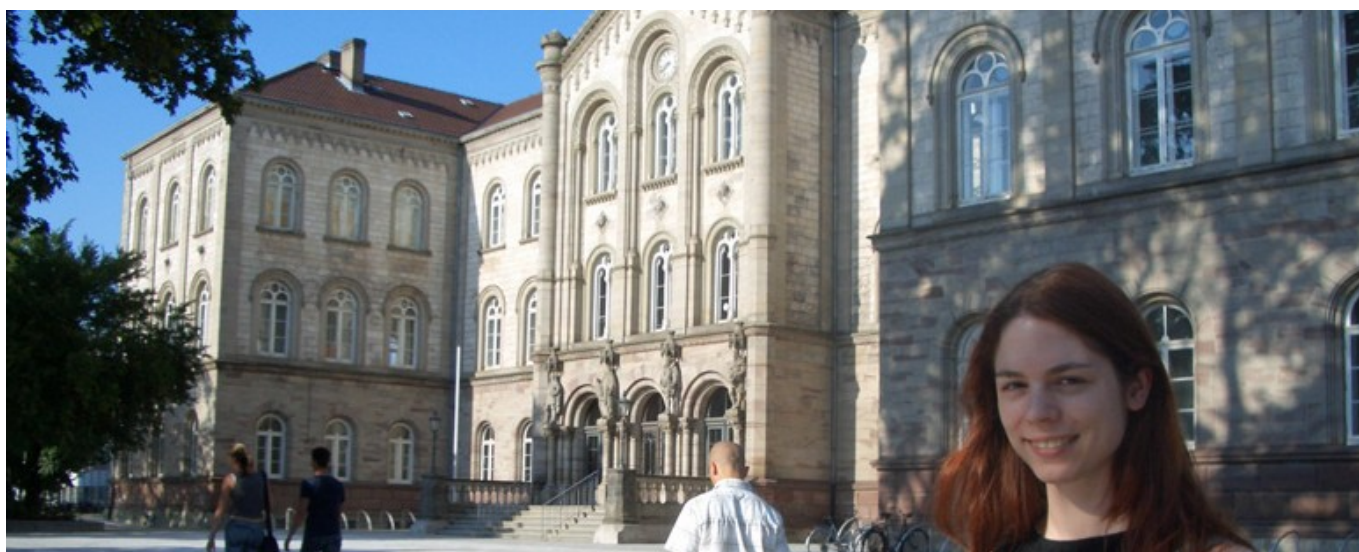

Of the 29,000 students, 4,500 students are international students.
