Target group	This course targets ERASMUS+ students and partnership students who will study at the University of Göttingen in the 2025/26 winter semester. The course is also open to participants who will not study in Göttingen or who are not participating in an exchange programme ("external participants").
Description/content	The aim of the international autumn course is to make it easier for international students to settle into the university by offering a language preparation course before the start of the lecture period. Besides the intensive general German lessons (communication in everyday life combined with elements of cultural studies), there will be an extensive programme of extracurricular activities to get to know the town of Göttingen and its surrounding area. The course is also open to participants who aren't studying in Göttingen or who are not participating in an exchange programme.
