The programme covers general language skills, basic vocabulary, and grammatical and idiomatic structures as well as an introduction to German culture and life. Extra communication and pronunciation exercises will strengthen your skills. The course also includes a visit to the opera or to a classical concert as well as several guided tours to cultural and historical landmarks. Our additional "German Culture & Society: Intercultural Perspectives" module will offer you the chance to reflect on your cross-cultural experience in greater detail.
