Intensive German courses are offered at levels B2-C1 of the European Framework of Reference for Languages. You will expand your vocabulary and your knowledge of German grammar, train your oral and written communication skills and learn a lot about German culture. Group and project tasks allow creative use of the German language. Upon successful completion of the course, you will receive a certificate and 5 ECTS points.</p> <p>Apart from the daily lessons, there is a lot more to learn during varied group activities, excursions in the Aachen region and European city trips to Amsterdam and Paris!</p>
