m te er sc ex Li to de Th	the field of mechatronics includes all areas of technology in which components of electronics, nechanics, and informatics interact. Apart from improving language skills by using relevant echnical terminology, the teaching project encompasses the analysis of graphics/diagrams on ingineering science topics. The course also includes reading practice through the use of popular cientific texts and technical resources. Teaching is connected to real-life situations and includes extracurricular learning venues in addition to the lessons in class. Inguistically, the focus is on communication and a confident use of the German language, adapted as specific situations. Grammatical knowledge and technical language aspects are practised and eveloped as appropriate to the upper level. The course amounts to 25 hours per week (17 hours of general language and eight hours of echnical language).
