Additionally, the course enables you to tackle complex prediction tasks using different information sources. Finally, the course gives you relevant data analytics skills such as the description, visualisation and statistical analysis of such predictions. We will use the programming language Python to apply the above-mentioned concepts.  All essential programming skills are taught in this course, and there are no prior programming skills required. |
