The specialisation in digital business management prepares you for leadership and specialist roles in the field of digital businesses, either in start-ups or in larger firms. You will extend and broaden your knowledge in areas such as digital leadership, digital marketing or digital entrepreneurship.

The Master of Science in Business Management begins in October and runs over the course of 24 months. The distance-learning programme is divided into three sections:

- Phase one: You will learn and build upon fundamental concepts, theories and applications
 of business administration. You will develop an essential understanding of management
 with a special emphasis on digital business.
- Phase two: Through the elective modules, you will specialise in digital business management.
- Phase three: your Master's thesis
