goods industry, in media, licensing and event agencies or in the sponsoring departments of global corporations. By specialising with a particular elective module, you can focus on topics such as the

football industry and qualify for challenging positions in clubs, associations and agencies in football business.

Requirements / Registration

Academic admission
requirements

- A Bachelor's degree in a business or management-related subject with minimum 180 credit points (ECTS)
- English language skills (details see below)
- Completed online application
- Admissions interview (online)

Required documents for the online application:

- Letter of Motivation
- Curriculum Vitae (CV) in English
- Certified copies of the Bachelor's degree certificate and transcript of records
- English language proficiency certificate (IELTS or TOEFL)

Language requirements

English language proficiency proven by IELTS (6.0 or higher) or TOEFL iBT (80 or higher) certificate

Applicants who have successfully completed an undergraduate degree in English and/or in English-speaking countries whose first language is English can be exempt from having to prove their English language level.

Application deadline

October intake

- 1 September for EU applicants and applicants not requiring a visa to enter Germany
