Taught by a dedicated staff—including three full professors in American Studies—the IAS programme aims at enabling students to apply the tools and approaches developed by different disciplines to advance a critical understanding of the American experience in a global context. The programme can be completed in either three of four years, depending on whether you will choose to spend an extra year studying at a partner university abroad and/or doing internships.  During the first year, the basic modules in literary and cultural studies will introduce our students to the main methods and concepts used to study American literature and culture. Each of these modules consists of a lecture and a seminar, accompanied by a turviolal in the advanced and focus modules, students depen their knowledge of American literature and culture and apply the skills acquired in the basic modules in a series of thematic research seminars and lecture.  Our students enjoy a high degree of autonomy in selecting topics for the three modules of the elective curriculum. Depending on your interests, you can take courses in fields as diverse as history, media studies, political science, sociology, art history, connomics, or law.
