Services

Possibility of finding part-time employment	In general, students from European Union countries do not require a work permit to work during their course of study. Students from countries outside the European Union may work 120 full days or 240 half days over the course of one year without a work permit. A special permit is required to work more than this. There might be student jobs at Hochschule Bremen.
Accommodation	There are student residences in Bremen, but most students live in private accommodation. In Bremen, a room costs between 300 and 400 EUR per month. A deposit consisting of the first month's rent, plus one or two additional months of rent, not including utility costs, is required before moving in.
