Description/content

The preparatory German courses of TU Braunschweig give you the opportunity to learn German language skills relevant to your studies within a short period of time.

Together with other international students, you will practice your German language skills and prepare for the "**Deutsch als Fremdsprache**" (TestDaF) test. If you have successfully passed the TestDaF exam at the end of the course, you can study at TU Braunschweig or another German university.

We teach language competence in all four skills (listening, reading, speaking, writing), paying particular attention to the university context. You will practise study-relevant skills (e.g. participation in discussions, preparation of papers, presentations, and teamwork) and learn more about cultural and regional aspects of Germany.

By the way: The A1 and A2 level courses are offered in hybrid format. You can also attend them if you are unable to be in Germany at the start of the course.
