The programme is supplemented by a wide range of offers and lectures, which will make it easier for participants to start their studies.

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The Technische Hochschule Mittelhessen (THM) is the one of the largest universities of applied sciences in Germany and the largest in the state of Hesse. It has its roots in the centre of Hesse and thus has particularly strong ties to partners in the region (e.g. companies, municipalities). With its 12 faculties and the Centre for Cooperative Degrees, THM offers 79 degree programmes to over 15,000 students, of which 12% are internationals (data from winter semester 2023/24).
