Academic admission requirements

For admission to the 1.5-year Master of Business Administration (MBA) programme at Hochschule Fresenius, candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Bachelor's Degree: Applicants must have successfully completed a Bachelor's degree programme from an accredited institution.
- Professional Experience: Candidates are required to have a minimum of one year of professional experience post-completion of their Bachelor's degree.
- Language Proficiency: Proficiency in English at level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) is mandatory, with appropriate documentation required.

Language requirements	<p>Applicants must provide proof of their English skills at a level B2 through one of the following methods:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TOEFL (minimum 80 points Internet-based) • IELTS (minimum 6.5) • minimum of 60 ECTS from a Bachelor's programme conducted in English • internal test of Fresenius University of Applied Sciences
