The culturally diverse backgrounds of the students turn discussions into a personal experience and a source of knowledge.</p> <p>The language courses consist of 25 hours of teaching per week. You can choose between the following language levels: beginners, intermediate and advanced level. Our weekly programme will be rounded off by additional offers like seminars, intercultural workshops, workshops for pronunciation and scientific German, movie nights, sports, get-</p> |

togethers and parties. These additional offers amount to at least 10 hours per week.
