

Appendix 1 – Funding requirements

regarding scholarship programme

“A New Passage to India – German-Indian Higher Education Cooperations 2019–2023”

1. Personnel resources in Germany

- **Project coordination** up to 50% FTE post EG13
- **Financial administration** EG 8 (50%)
- **Research associates/Student assistants** according to required effort and local rates of the university

2. Material resources in Germany/abroad

- **Fees**
As previously agreed with the DAAD for specific cases. Please consider the DAAD table of fees with regard to appropriateness of fees.
- **Other material funding**
e.g. for organisation of events, public relations, conference participation fees
- **Mobility and visits of German university project staff**
Travel expenditures of German university staff should be claimed in accordance with the German Federal Travel Expenses Act (BRKG). Only economy class flights and 2nd class train journeys are eligible for funding.
