Material resources

Fees

In principle, fees may only be applied for and claimed in individual cases and after approval by the DAAD. Please note the DAAD table of fees with regard to the appropriateness of fees (see Appendix 5).

Fees for assistants at the AIMS centre in South Africa may be applied for and claimed to a limited amount. In this case, the expenditure is based on the local rates.

Mobility of project personnel

Expenditure for the mobility of employees of the grant recipient may be claimed in accordance with the German Federal Travel Expenses Act (BRKG). Only economy class flights and 2nd class train journeys are eligible for funding.

Project staff stays

Expenditure for the stays of employees of the grant recipient may be claimed in accordance with the German Federal Travel Expenses Act (BRKG).

Material resources in Germany/abroad

- Room hire (rent for conference rooms etc.)
- Printing/publications/advertising and public relations (flyers, brochures, posters, scientific publications etc.)

If the doctoral candidate is **supervised** by the **chair holder** at AIMS South Africa, the student may complete a research stay in Germany for a maximum of six months while working on his or her doctoral project.

If the doctoral thesis is supervised jointly by the **German side and the chair holder** (double supervision), the doctoral candidate can spend half the scholarship period at the German higher education institution. The maximum stay is 12 consecutive months.

Expenditure for the usual local health insurance is eligible for funding.

<u>Note:</u> In the interests of economic efficiency, the German higher education institution can book a more affordable group insurance through the DAAD for scholarship holders staying in Germany.

<u>Note</u>: Graduates, doctoral candidates, postdocs and experienced academics at the AIMS centres in Ghana, Cameroon, Senegal and Rwanda may participate in an event organised in Germany within the scope of this project funding (e.g. summer school). Stays for this purpose are possible for a maximum of one month.

This also applies for academics from African higher education institutions who are cooperating with the chair holder and AIMS South Africa (e.g. work on a joint research project). Necessary health insurance expenses are covered by the mobility allowance. <u>Note:</u> Foreign guests should be urgently advised of the need for adequate insurance cover. The German higher education institution can book a more affordable group insurance through the DAAD.

V. Short stay for participation in events at AIMS South Africa and at networking and work meetings across the African continent

Expenditure for the mobility and visits of graduates, doctoral candidates and academics from other AIMS centres can be claimed for participation in events organised at AIMS South Africa within the scope of this project funding (e.g. summer school). This also applies for academics at African higher education institutions who are cooperating with the chair holder at AIMS South Africa South Africa (e.g. work on a joint research project).

In the interests of networking between administrative staff, expenditure for mobility and stays of employees from AIMS South Africa may also be claimed at work and networking meetings at other AIMS centres.

Mobility

Expenditure for mobility may be claimed in accordance with the principles of efficiency and economy by presenting individual receipts. Only expenditure for economy class flights and 2nd class train journeys is eligible for funding.

<u>Visits</u>

Expenditure for stays may be claimed in accordance with the principles of efficiency and economy by presenting individual receipts.

Expenditure for basic infrastructure equipment and capital goods is **not** eligible for funding.
