German-Iraqi Academic Partnerships in 2020 (extension)**

All expenditure that is necessary and appropriate for conducting the project (conducting of the measures) is eligible for funding. This includes in particular:

Personnel resources for conducting and supervising the project

- Personnel in Germany
 - Research associates
 - Academic assistants
 - Student assistants

Personnel expenditure covers gross employer remuneration. Special annual payments are only eligible for funding in the approval period and only if the date of payment is within this period.

Material resources (for conducting the project in Germany)

- Fees

For external lecturers (experts/trainers, no personnel of the grant recipient)

Hourly rate of up to	40 euros
Daily rate of up to	250 euros
- Mobility of project personnel

Expenditure on train journeys and flights made by personnel of the grant recipient must be claimed according to the German Travel Expenses Act (BRKG). The BRKG applies with the following restriction: second-class train journeys, economy-class flights. Due to the lack of separate provisions, the rates for Luxembourg must be used for travel to Iraq.
- Stays of project personnel

Expenditure on stays (daily and accommodation allowances) made by personnel of the grant recipient must be claimed according to the German Travel Expenses Act (BRKG).

- Material resources in Germany
 - Consumables
(communication expenditure, printing and copying costs, office supplies for workshops, conferences, events, etc.)
 - Economic goods
(hiring costs of computers, software, data projectors, chairs, tables, etc.; **no equipment purchases**)
 - Room hire
(hiring costs of conference rooms and conference technology, etc.)
 - Printing/publications/advertising and public relations
(flyers, brochures, posters, etc.)
 - Outsourced services
(catering, bus companies, IT support, etc.)
 - Other material expenditure
(excursion expenditure, teaching materials, etc.; **no gifts**)

Note:

Material resources for conducting events at higher education institutions in Turkey, Jordan and Iran only with the prior approval of the DAAD.

Expenditure on journeys **within Germany, Iran, Jordan and Turkey** must be claimed in accordance with the principles of economic efficiency and frugality.

- Stays of funded individuals (Germans in Iraq)

Living allowance lump sum for German students, graduates, doctoral candidates, academics/lecturers/assistants holding a PhD (The living allowance lump sum covers catering and accommodation costs as well as expenditure on health, accident and liability insurance.)
