

Grant expenditure eligible

German–Iraqi Academic Partnerships 2021–2022 German–Iraqi Academic Partnerships in 2021 (extension)

All expenditure that is necessary and appropriate for conducting the project (conducting of the measures) is eligible for funding. This includes in particular:

Personnel resources for conducting and supervising the project

- Staff
 - Research associates
 - Academic assistants
 - Student assistants

Personnel expenditure covers gross employer remuneration. Special annual payments are only eligible for funding in the approval period and only if the date of payment is within this period.

If there are problems employing student assistants for project-related administrative activities, an expenditure application may be made for TV-L employees (E8) instead.

Material resources (for conducting the project in Germany)

- Fees

For external lecturers (experts/trainers, no personnel of the grant recipient)

Hourly rate of up to	40 euros
Daily rate of up to	250 euros
- Mobility of project staff

Expenditure for journeys and flights may be claimed in accordance with the BRKG/LRKG. Only second-class train journeys and economy-class flights can be claimed. The rates for Luxembourg apply for travel to Iraq.
- Stays of project staff

Expenditure relating to stays (meals and accommodation) may be claimed in accordance with the BRKG/LRKG.
- Material resources in Germany
 - Consumables
(office supplies for workshops, conferences, events, etc.)
 - Economic goods
(hire of computers, software, data projectors, chairs, tables, etc.)
 - Room hire
(hiring costs of conference rooms and conference technology, etc.)
 - Printing/publications/advertising and public relations
(flyers, brochures, posters, social media, etc.)
 - Outsourced services
(bus companies, IT support, etc.)
 - Other
(expenditure for communications, excursions, teaching materials, etc.)

The following are not eligible for funding:
Equipment purchases, gifts

Note:

Material resources for conducting events at higher education institutions in Turkey, Jordan, Iran or safe third countries can be recognised as eligible for funding only with the prior approval of the DAAD.

Funded individuals

- **Mobility of funded individuals**

Mobility lump sum (Germany ↔ Iraq/Iran/Jordan/Turkey)

For **participants from the German side** taking part in teaching and research visits and attending summer schools, seminars, workshops, specialist events and special courses **in Iraq, Iran, Jordan or Turkey**, a one-off **country-specific mobility lump sum** can be claimed per participant.

Mobility lump sum (Iraq ↔ Germany)

For **participants from the Iraqi side** taking part in teaching and research visits and attending summer schools, seminars, workshops and **special courses in Germany**, a one-off **country-specific mobility lump sum** of **775 euros** can be claimed per participant and event.

The mobility lump sum takes effect from the first day of travel and will be verified using signed participant lists. The mobility lump sum covers all costs connected with the trip (e.g. visa fees, health certificate, vaccinations, luggage charges, luggage insurance).

Mobility (between Iraq ↔ Iran, Iraq ↔ Jordan, Iraq ↔ Turkey as well as within Germany and within these countries)

For German and Iraqi participants, expenses for journeys and flights may be claimed in accordance with the principles of economic efficiency and frugality.

- **Stay of funded individuals**

Living allowances

For **participants from the German side** taking part in teaching and research visits and attending summer schools, seminars, workshops, specialist events and special courses **in Iraq, Iran, Jordan or Turkey**, the daily or monthly living allowances for these countries can be claimed per participant based on status.

For participants from the **Iraqi side** taking part in teaching and research visits and attending summer schools, seminars, workshops, specialist events and special courses **in Iran, Jordan or Turkey**, the daily or monthly living allowances for these countries can be claimed per participant based on status.
