We provide information, advice and support for all those who wish to start studying or to continue an interrupted study programme in Germany. We explain how study programmes are organised, which requirements there are in order to study in Germany and what the possibilities are for studying in the region Brandenburg.

Additionally, we can offer information and advice in refugee accommodation in around Potsdam, in order to help you take the first steps towards taking up a study programme.

We are also keen to build networks with universities in the region; communal accommodation and housing initiatives; migration advice centres; refugee initiatives; language schools; job centres and authorities.

Subject-specific guidance is provided by a board of higher education experts under the leadership of the vicepresident for international affairs, Prof. Dr. Hermann Voesgen.

In the advice centre **HERE!**, we provide:


- information about the German university system and study programmes in the region Brandenburg
