AT A GLANCE

- Feropedia is a non-profit foundation which targets teachers of different fields, educators and parents, schools, educational institutions, and universities.
- Feropedia works on preparing educational articles, resources, teacher training programmes to its readers via online learning management systems (LMS) legibly, audibly and visibly.
- The foundation was launched by a group of educators, teachers, teacher trainers and researchers in the field of education residing in Syria and Kurdistan Region – Iraq.
- Feropedia Foundation currently provides its services in Kurdish (Sorani) language, and it aims to include both Kurdish (Kurmanji) and Arabic as its next step to reach more than 300M in the Middle East and North Africa Region.
- The foundation is personally funded and entirely based on volunteering.

CORE OBJECTIVES

1. Establish a place where students, parents, teachers, educators and administrators are all empowered to change education for the better.
2. Promote quality education, rigorous project-based learning, social-emotional learning, and access to new technology in schools, universities and educational institutions.
3. Create a place where both teachers and students become lifelong learners and develop 21st-century skills.

- Feropedia is the first Kurdish educational platform that provides quality teaching resources and materials for teachers, teacher trainers and parents in the Kurdish language.
- More than 10000 visitors on a monthly bases.
- Run a good number of workshops and seminar in collaboration with local educational institutions and universities to increase the quality of education.
- Established a vibrant community where educators, teachers and educational institutions are encouraged to innovate and incorporated new teaching practices into their education culture.
- Encourage local educators to research and publish their own materials and sources on Feropedia Platform.

2. Different educational institutions have positively used the resources and incorporated them into their contexts.
3. A community of active volunteers from different walks of society has been established.
