

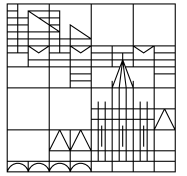

AN ACCOMPANYING PROGRAMME FOR SYRIAN SCHOLARS - LEADERSHIP FOR SYRIA

AT A GLANCE

- Accompanying blended learning programme for 190 Syrian scholarship holders studying in Master or PhD programmes mainly in sciences, engineering and medicine at German universities
- Financed by the German Foreign Ministry and the state of North Rhine Westphalia with the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) responsible
- Three fields of activity: Democratic Understanding of Society, Sustainable Economic Policy and Personal Competence
- Additional offer: methodological training Design Thinking, intercultural awareness, leadership training univenture and an Open Space
- Two times 12 weeks online learning and three face-to-face workshops in Konstanz
- Programme start in November 2016 and end of programme in July 2017
- Programme is scalable in the dimensions of structure, modules, content and participants
- Programme offers both a learning and teaching approach and a framework for other target groups

CORE OBJECTIVES

1. To equip the scholars with the political and administrative skills they will need to take on leadership roles and substantially contribute to the rebuilding of their native country
2. To learn whether a blended learning format fits the needs of a specific target group from a crisis region
3. To develop further education modules based on teaching and research in the Department of Politics and Public Administration at the University of Konstanz for new and heterogenous target groups

ACHIEVEMENTS SO FAR

- Programme successfully completed by 152 scholars (Certificate Leadership for Syria with 6 ECTS Credits)
- Evaluated positively by participants and by DAAD
- "Very interesting information and important for the future life not only from the political side but also for every job opportunity."

LESSONS LEARNT

1. Methodologically e-learning is an effective and efficient programme framework
2. The scientifically based discourse has to be related to training approaches
3. Open discourse formats lead the way to concrete transfer approaches
